

Myth 11 Improvements in air quality?

The council's recent Air Quality modelling report showed that the planned changes to the station gyratory will significantly reduce the air quality problems at the station. Once this is in place (Why is it taking so long? Is it because it suits the Tories to have lots of people sitting in traffic? Why wasn't it done before?) the additional air quality benefits of the NWRR are minimal and there are cheaper options that will help.

In fact, the council's recent air quality modelling shows that because of the extra car journeys created by the road the total amount of NOx emissions will increase meaning average air quality is worse across Shrewsbury.
